Citation	Article IV: Convention
Current Language	Section 5, E: Resolutions to be considered at the Convention must be postmarked to the President sixty (60) days in advance of the Convention's opening date. All Resolutions must be sponsored by a Delegate. Resolutions postmarked after that date may be considered with the approval of the Convention. Copies of all Resolutions received in a timely manner shall be provided to all Delegates. The Resolutions Committee shall have the authority to consolidate like Resolutions on the same subject.
Proposed Language	Section 5, E: Resolutions to be considered at the Convention must be postmarked or emailed to the President and staff sixty (60) days in advance of the Convention's opening date. All Resolutions must be sponsored by a Delegate. Resolutions postmarked after that date may be considered with the approval of the Convention. Copies of all Resolutions received in a timely manner shall be provided to all Delegates. The Resolutions Committee shall have the authority to consolidate like Resolutions on the same subject.
